

As part of the Sabi Sand Reserve and greater Kruger National Park, Arathusa is in one of the world's most abundant natural wilderness areas where hundreds of animal species roam free.

Including the much acclaimed Big Five (lion, leopard, rhino, elephant, and buffalo – the five most dangerous animal species to be hunted on foot). Leopards, in specific, are abundant in this region with perhaps the globe's highest population. Arathusa prides itself on its leopard viewing. As these elusive cats are territorial, we have regular appearances in the area, as well as a pack of wild dogs.
